Limits for certificate receipt

nutritionDay participants receive a certificate! To receive the nD certificate, three quality criteria have to be met:

1. Minimum of 8 patients/residents have to be included in the audit per unit (this is also the minimum number required to receive a unit report).
2. Minimum of 60% of all patients/residents present on nD have to be included in the nD audit.
3. Minimum of 80% of patients/residents (which have participated in nutritionDay) have to be included in the outcome evaluation 30 days (hospitals) or 180 days (nursing homes) after nD.

Deadlines for participants

Please consider the deadlines for registration, outcome evaluation, entry in database and receipt of the final unit reports. Do not forget to also record outcome data after 30, 60 or 180 days after nutritionDay for your setting.
