



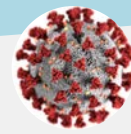

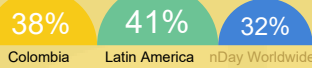

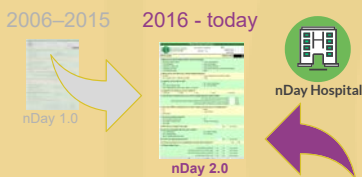
2009-2015 nutritionDay survey
